

The MARS GAMING’s MK2 is a standard 104 keys layout illuminated gaming keyboard. It consists of six micro keys G1-G6, and a software allows macro setting and self-defined hot keys. It also includes nine multimedia keys and three self-defined function keys (M1/M2/M3). MAX memory space is 64KB and store 18 sets MACRO keys to the keyboard, so no need to set the profiles again when moving to another computer.

Note: You will not be able to enter password to the internet banking when keyboard is in gaming mode, it is workable when keyboard is changed into the normal mode. (The windows key is available when keyboard in normal mode, but no any function in gaming mode)

Note: Please uninstall previous keyboard software (if any) from your PC, then double-click setup.exe to install MK2 software onto your PC.



Go to the Main screen after the software installation.



Key functions can be re-assigned simply by selecting a key (inverted to red color) and choose a key to replace its previous function. (multimedia keys and special function keys can not be re-assigned)



Go to MACRO SETTING



Click MACRO MANAGER and click NEW



Type in a new Macro name and click OK



Click Start Record and start inputting combination of keys. You can also set the number of Loop Times and choose to Record delays between key commands.



Any of the G1-G6 keys can be assigned as a Macro or a multimedia key.



Assigning the newly recorded Macro to any of the G1-G6 keys.



In the ADVANCED SETTING, you can set the POLLING RATE, KEY RESPONSE TIME, selecting the keyboard backlight LED color and the LIGHT INTENSITY.
